



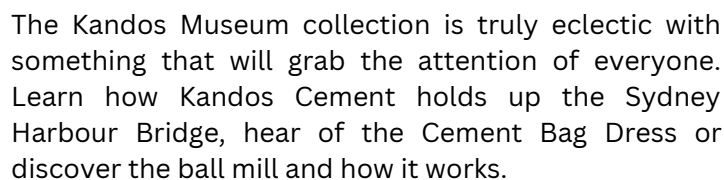
Planning a group visit to the stunning Mudgee Region? Make Kandos Museum your destination gateway partner.

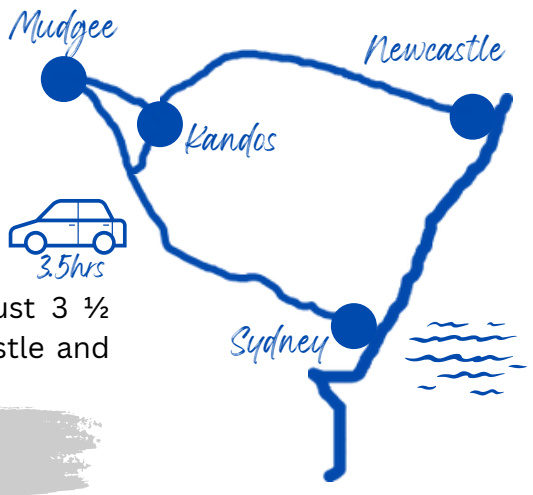
Not sure where Kandos & Mudgee are?
